

Key to genera of World Xoridinae (Hymenoptera: Ichneumonidae)

1. Apex of mandible unidentate. Epomia unusually long and strong, usually projecting dorsally as tooth (Fig. 1). Flagellum of female curved or elbowed subapically, with one, two, or series of peglike setae at curve or elbow (Figs. 2-3).
..... ***Xorides*** Latreille
- 1'. Apex of mandible bidentate (Fig. 4). Epomia absent or present only as low carina that never projects dorsally (Fig. 5-6). Flagellum of female not specialized subapically (as described above) (Fig. 7).
..... 2
2. Hind femur with strong median ventral tooth (Fig. 8).
..... ***Odontocolon*** Gravenhorst
- 2'. Hind femur without median ventral tooth (Fig. 9).
..... 3
3. Supra-antennal area with strong median apophysis (Fig. 10). Mesosoma subcylindric (Fig. 11). Head in lateral view with length of eye = length of gena (Fig. 12).
..... ***Ischnoceros*** Gravenhorst
- 3'. Supra-antennal area without median apophysis or tubercle (Fig. 13). Mesosoma flattened (Fig. 14). Head in lateral view with length of eye < length of gena (Fig. 15).
..... ***Aplomerus*** Provancher
